Use "words that work" to educate patients and their loved ones on the importance of safety and fall prevention.

## Suggestions include:

### When placing yellow fall risk arm band



"This arm band lets our staff know that you may need my help. We want to partner with you and we are here to keep you safe."

#### When offering a ride in a wheelchair

- "I am concerned that it's a long walk to the exam room. For your safety and to save your energy, I'll give you a ride in a wheelchair."
- "If you don't want to ride in the wheelchair, you can put your belongings in the seat and push the wheelchair. I'll walk next to you."

#### When using lift equipment

"For your safety, we will use this lift to help you move. It will also be more comfortable."
