Exporting Chemicals outside of the United States

When certain chemical substances are exported or hand carried out of the United States, the EPA must be notified in writing. In some instances the notification is a "one time" notification and in other cases the EPA must be notified annually. If you are exporting or hand carrying a chemical to a foreign country, download and search the <u>TSCA CORR Chemical List</u> for which notification is required. This list can be found in a variety of formats in the left margin and contains many common laboratory chemicals. If the chemical substance you are exporting is on the list a notification is necessary. Review the <u>TSCA Export</u> <u>Decision Tree</u> to determine the correct course of action and contact the <u>OESO EP TSCA Coordinator</u> for assistance in making the notification.

The Department of Transportation regulates the transport of chemicals and all packages of chemicals must be packed and labeled in accordance with their regulations prior to shipment. Contact the OESO EP for assistance in packing the chemical substances you are shipping within or outside the United States.
