Installation and Storage of Alcohol-based Hand Sanitizers in Duke University Facilities

The following guidance is applicable to all Duke University facilities (Does not pertain to Duke Health System Facilities)

- 1. If dispensers are mounted in a corridor, the minimum corridor width shall be 72 inches.
- 2. The maximum allowable quantity of alcohol-based hand rub (ABHR) product (in use and storage within a control area) shall not exceed 1 container per 71 square feet and a maximum 31 ABHR dispensers each with a maximum capacity of 41 ounces within a control area.
 - · Unless otherwise specified, a control area is defined as a floor.
- 3. The maximum allowable quantity of ABHR stored outside of an approved flammable liquid storage cabinet shall not exceed 5 gallons. ("Stored" means not contained in a product dispenser.)
 - · Storage amounts exceeding 5 gallons must be contained within an NFPA 30 compliant flammable storage cabinet that includes the following features:
 - o Cabinets must have self-closing doors.
 - o Cabinet doors must have a 3-point latching mechanism.
 - o Note: All storage locations must be approved by OESO Fire and Life Safety.
- 4. The maximum capacity of ABHR dispensers shall not exceed 41 ounces.
 - Storage containers may be larger provided they are not used for dispensing the product.

NOTE: Use of aerosol/pressurized dispensers for ABHR was discontinued; therefore, applicable guidance has been removed from this document.

- 5. The minimum separation between dispensers shall be 48 inches.
- 6. Dispensers not mounted or in stands are prohibited. Loose dispensers must be relocated to an appropriate storage location.
- 7. Dispensers shall not be installed above, below, or closer than 1 inch to an electrical receptacle, switch, appliance, device or other ignition source. Dispensers shall not be located in small compartment spaces such as elevator cabs.
- 8. Dispensers shall not be mounted on doors.
- 9. Dispensers may be mounted over carpet provided the facility is equipped throughout with an automatic sprinkler system.
- 10. Broken or damaged dispensers shall be immediately removed from service.
