

FLUORESCENT LIGHT MANAGEMENT

PROPER DISPOSAL

- Spent lamps should be placed into empty lamp boxes for proper disposal.
- Be sure to:

⇒ Properly label container with one of the following:

- ◇ “Universal Waste—Lamp(s)”
- ◇ “Universal Waste—Waste Lamp(s)”
- ◇ “Universal Waste—Used Lamps”

⇒ Enter *accumulation start date* on the container label with the earliest date that the first lamp was placed in the container

⇒ Keep container closed at all times except when adding or removing lamps from the container

⇒ Engineering and Operations and Facilities Departments should use their designated collection areas. Faculty, staff or students should contact Environmental Programs for assistance.

⇒ NOTE: Spent lamps can only be stored for 1 year
